1. The Republic of Tajikistan has received financing from the Asian Development Bank's (ADB) Clean Energy Fund toward the cost of **Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation Corridors 2, 5, and 6 (Dushanbe–Kurgonteppa) Road Project**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the Contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. **The Ministry of Transport of the Republic of Tajikistan** ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the **construction of clean energy components** ("the Works"). The works comprise (i) solar-powered pumped water supply (Dushanbe-Kurgonteppa road km 5+000-14+300 lhs); (ii) solar back-up power supply for school and medical post, Obishfo and Hayoti Nav (Dushanbe-Kurgonteppa road km 6+000-7+000 lhs); and (iii) LED road lighting for Ozodi tunnel (Dushanbe-Dangara road).
3. **National Competitive Bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's [Single Stage: One-Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with the following **key qualifications** should participate in this bidding:
 - Current soundness of the Bidder's financial position; as a minimum, the Bidder's net worth for the last year should be positive.
 - Minimum Average Annual Construction Turnover within the last three (3) years: US\$ 3,200,000.
 - Financial resources less financial obligations for current contract commitments: Not less than US\$ 800,000.
 - Participation as a contractor, Joint Venture partner, or Subcontractor in at least one contract completed within the last five (5) years: US\$ 1,280,000.
 - Construction experience:
 - design and construction of at least one (1) pumped water supply project, using solar-power panels, but automatically interchangeable with mains power when required, with high pressure plunger pumps (estimated maximum pressure 7.35MPa), with a minimum lift of 400m, with a minimum capacity of 80 m³/h
 - Supply and installations of minimum 30 solar mono or polycrystalline silicon solar panels (Type 250 WP, 320Wp, or similar) for back-up power supply
 - Supply and installations of minimum 250 tunnel or streetlight LED lamps

This document summarizes only a part of the requirements for information to the potential bidders. Bidders are requested to refer to the Bidding Document for the full range of criteria prior to submitting a bid. If there are any discrepancies between this Invitation for Bid and the Bidding Document, the Bidding Document shall prevail.
